Food and Want They eat out of Buffalo and Want They Make out of him so They ues Bones To Make a scraper and along with hoes, knives and they use The tail to Make a fly swatter They also eat The blood and intestines For food They use ribs for sled runners They use The Bladder For Waterproof bags They use The Fat it to Make Pemmican They use The Liver for to tan hides and the spoons, and cups, clubs With Horns They use The brain to tan hides They use They Hooves For glue They use the head as in hair For headbands, lariat,s and belts They use dried dung For fuel They use The Hump For special delicacy They ues The Teeth For necklaces The skull can Be used For religious ceremonies They use The hide For clothing, tipis, covers, blankets, and moccasins For The Clothing and more. Let me tell you about the buffalo and how the First Nation's use the all parts of the buffalo. the first nation's carve out the inside of the buffalo horn and use it as a cup or make it into a spoon. The first nation's used the cups for drinking water and juice by squeezing the fruit. Also, they used the spoon for eating they also use the spoon for eating soup. The first nation's use the the buffalo skin for tipi's. They use tipi as shelter and to cook in and also sleep in the tipi's. The top of the tipi has a flap so smoke could get out. They would put their belongings in the tipi for the day. The buffalo's skin from the but is used for robes they wear robes so they don't get cold and if they get too hot they have other pairs of clothes. The first nation's people use the tail to make fly swatters they put a stick on the end of the tail because if flies were annoying them thed swat them. They use the buffalo's leg to make swords then once they have a lot they go out and kill more buffalo than they have more leg bones to make more swords and they go out again and the more they kill the more swords which means more food and defence they shouldn't eat too much meat because it can give you disease. Buffalo its rib bone is for knives they use it for tanning and scraping bacteria of. The first nation people call the buffalo the supermarket because they can make a lot of stuff out of it.

So, you want to understand how the First Nations used their tools

The hooves of a bison was very much like glue because the First Nations people mixed water with the hooves to make it sticky.This is because they didn't have much things that could stick one thing to another.

The ribs of a bison were used for sled runners.

This is because the First Nations couldn't carry their stuff around with their arms all the time so the First Nations made sled runners out of the bison's ribs. I think it would be much like the runners were you have to get some dogs and ropes and you would have to tie the rope to the dog's neck and tie the other end onto sled then the dog's would pull the sled and that's what I think the sled runners were used for.

The bison's tail was used for fly swatters the fly swatter was used for well swatting flies. This was because the flies were a food source and the flies would probably try to eat the food that the First Nations hunted.

The horn of a bison was used for spoons and horns [the ones that you blow in]. This was because the First Nations didn't want their food all dirty so when some of the hunters brought the parts of a bison the horns were made into spoons. Also the First Nations used the horn of a bison for horns. This was because if the town was in danger they would blow the horn and the hunters would start running to the town and fight.

The bow was a great hunting tool. This is because you didn't need to get up so close to kill the animal[s].
